Therefore, the International Consortium for Harmonization in Laboratory Medicine (ICHCLR) and The European Organisation for External Quality Assurance Providers in Laboratory Medicine (EQALM), have joined forces for an initiative called HALMA. The acronym stands for **HA**rmonization of measurands in **L**aboratory **M**edicine through data **A**ggregation and aims to collect and aggregate results from different EQA providers that use commutable samples.
