Minutes:

1. Organizational Member promotion

Gary Myers updated the group on the new organizational member level. After the introduction of the new membership category, CAP has joined at this level. Dr. Anthony Killeen will serve as their representative to the HOG and is present on this call. ICHCLR will work on contacting members of the strategic partners group and inform them of this new opportunity. Gary requested that any contacts at other organizations that might be interested be sent to him or Stefanie. Dues for the new level are \$10,000 per year. A key benefit of this new level is that an organizational member can appoint a representative to serve on HOG.

Mr. Passarelli has requested information to provide to his own organization. He also informed the group regarding constraints on some organizations funding various activities and the importance of clarifying the purpose of the ICHCLR and the value of participation at the organizational member category. He offered to assist with the information that will be sent to other corporate members. Gary will send him information at the end of the week. It was also suggested that the information packet/message be tailored to the potential member.

2. Website update status

Stefanie has updated the prioritization table with all of the measurands discussed so far. All suggested updates have been completed except one, including the ability to link to organizations although the links have not yet been populated. The exception is the ability to hover over links to have information pop up. IT continues to work on this project.

Stefanie will set up a conference call with Greg, Gary and AACC's IT department to discuss outstanding issues with the table and web content. Examples of these issues include: links should go to a new tab, page wrapping, etc.

Stefanie will remove the Medical importance entry from any measurand where harmonization status is adequate on the measurand table.
